
EXCITING NEWS!!!

"In just the span of one week, God has proven that He can and will turn my world upside down. I won't lie; I came into Camp Hope extremely overwhelmed. The first day was very difficult and I now realize that the enemy was doing everything he could to discourage us - to halt the plan God had for the week. However, the enemy has no power over us! I prayed to the Father and gave Him my 'yes.' I didn't know what that looked like and I certainly didn't know what God had in store, but I surrendered the week to Him. Oh my, did He blow my expectations out of the water. He completely reshaped my heart. He is teaching me how to love like He does. He taught me compassion, forgiveness, and patience through the children at Camp Hope. I saw my reflection in the campers. When they would reject us or turn from us, I saw my own disobedience in the face of the Father. I am so thankful that Jesus restores, forgives, and rewrites our stories. He is working at Camp Hope, and He gave me the privilege to see it face to face. One day during Bible Time, a young boy told me that he wanted to be saved. He told me how badly he craved to be in Heaven with the Father. His curiosity and hunger was beautiful. We prayed together and his smile was bigger than I had ever seen it! He later went on to ask about how he could control his anger and be kind like Jesus. In this exact same way, Jesus is rewriting the lives of the children at camp. He is accepting their stories and their pasts. He is giving life. I will never stop thanking Him for giving me the opportunity to see it. Praise God!"
